The Conference

The **AIAA Region II Student Conference** is the premier annual event for aerospace engineering students across the Southeastern United States. Each year, the conference brings together hundreds of the region's brightest undergraduate and graduate students—along with faculty, industry professionals, and government representatives—for two days of technical presentations, professional development, and networking.

The **77th Annual Conference**, hosted by the **University of South Carolina**, will take place **March 26–27, 2026**, in **Columbia, South Carolina**—a growing aerospace hub in the Southeast.

This conference gives students the opportunity to present original research and design projects in a professional forum modeled after AIAA's national conferences. Professionals from industry, academia, and government serve as judges, offering feedback, mentorship, and insight as they evaluate the top papers and presentations in several competition categories.

Beyond the technical sessions, the conference includes:

- **An Opening Keynote Address**
- **A Networking Luncheon** featuring a distinguished speaker
- **A Recruiting & Employer Hall** open throughout the first day
- **A Professional Mixer and Networking Reception**
- **An Awards Banquet and Winners' Reception** to close the conference.

This event showcases innovation, connects talent with opportunity, and fosters the next generation of aerospace professionals.

Badge Sponsor

Your logo on every attendee's badge—high visibility from start to finish. (1 available)

Silver-Level Opportunities

Technical Session Sponsor – Full Day

Support the student paper presentations at the heart of the conference. Includes signage in session rooms and acknowledgment in the program. (multiple available)

Swag Bag Sponsor

Your logo on every attendee's conference bag—maximum visibility that lasts long after the event. (1 available)

Gold-Level Opportunities

Winner's Reception Sponsor

Celebrate student success and mingle with award recipients, judges, and professionals. Includes event signage and verbal acknowledgment. (1 available)

Opening Keynote Sponsor

Be the first name attendees hear. Includes a 2–4 minute live introduction and/or short corporate video before the keynote speaker, plus premier logo placement during the session. (1 available)

Conference Luncheon Sponsor

Engage attendees mid-conference with a captive audience during the Luncheon. Includes a 2–4 minute speaking opportunity and/or corporate video presentation. (2 available)

Platinum-Level Opportunities

Awards Banquet Sponsor (Priority to the first two Platinum Plus sponsors, then Platinum sponsors)

The signature event of the conference. Includes logo placement on all banquet materials, and the opportunity for an extended (≤ 5 minutes) live or video segment during the Awards Banquet. (2 available).

Place a branded photo backdrop or display sign in a high-traffic area. Every conference photo becomes a brand moment. (3 available)

Gold-Level Opportunities

Box Lunch Sponsor

Provide lunch for students during the final day of the conference. Includes branding during distribution and recognition in the program. (1 available)

Morning Coffee & Refreshments Sponsor

Feature your logo as attendees gather for the opening session. Includes branded coffee stations or signage. (2 available)
